Obsidian – *Clothing Ecommerce Website*

- Collaborated with 2 team members to develop an ecommerce clothing website where users could shop online.
- Designed and implemented the UI for the landing page, catalog page, favourites page, and checkout page using CSS and Bootstrap.
- Created dynamic components which displayed item data retrieved from the MySQL database.
- Utilized PHP for server-side scripting to implement a shopping cart and wishlist feature for authenticated users.

- Coordinated with a team of 5 to create a full-stack web application that mimics a medical clinic system that manages patient accounts and their data.
